Technical Rider for Production of – '69 Seasons

PLEASE NOTE - All of the following technical requirements are integral to the performance. If any of the requirements included here cannot be met, please contact EbzB Productions promptly via email at <u>ebzb@ebzb.org</u>, or via phone call at 919-387-4616. While the production allows for flexibility of venues, it is essential to discuss and approve the changes before a

commitment to perform is made in order to ensure the highest quality performance. There are no
specific measurements or exact scale included in the attached light plot and instrument schedule,
particularly in regard to electrics, batten-drop placement, cyc, scrim, et. al. This is intentional
due to the variation of venues in which the performance is presented, with the design included
here for optimum facility conditions. Production expectations are flexible and can be tailored to
the capability of individual facilities.
Performance Space -
Climate-controlled (performance) venue with a clear performing area (flat or
'raked') no less than 10'x10' with a height clearance of 10'. Ideal performance
venues range in seating capacity from 100 to 2,000 seats. (For further reference
see standard performance set design/lay-out on page 3.)
Staging -
For theatre venues of 100 to 1,000 seats - flexible staging is possible for this
production. The performance can be done on a proscenium stage, thrust, or in-
the-round. If done proscenium style on a large venue stage, standard blacks
(curtains) or standard flats are highly recommended to tighten the performance
space. (For further reference, please refer to the accompanying standard performance set
design/lay-out on page 3).
For other performance venues such as school flex-spaces ('café-toriums')
or other venues not inherently considered 'theatre' venues - flexible staging is
also possible for these performance spaces. Minimalization of any external forms of light
penetrating the performance area is highly recommended when possible, with a
preference for full-stage 'black-out' capability.
Lighting - *
Front Light - Warm and cool full washes
Back Light - Warm and cool full washes
Specials – two musician specials – from above placement of musicians for potential
ensemble orchestration (There are four (4) musicians - one special per each pair of musicians;
lighting special for keyboard is essential).
Floor lighting for stage ingress and egress of band ensemble.
*Please see attached light plot for further details. EbzB Productions makes these lighting
recommendations for traditional theatre venues and provides source-4, size B(4") gobos when
appropriate for use in capable facilities.
Please Note - Please have specified lights assigned and hung, with gels, and washes rough-
focused BEFORE arrival and technical rehearsal in venue. Specials and remaining lighting
assignments can then be focused during the tech and load-in.
<u>Multi-Media Option –</u>
Venue must have rear-view or front-view projection capability and appropriate cable
connection compatible with mac/ibook laptop computer for power-point program use.

This production includes the use of digital projections via projector on to a cyc or scrim. The company does not generally travel with projector or screen (cyc or scrim). These are expected to be supplied or rented by venue. However, EbzB Productions is willing to consider travel with portable screen apparatus and projector for specific requests.

Sound -

Sound system suitable for size of venue is recommended. Music is performed live for this performance with minimal incidental music cues.

One CD Player wired through venue's system.

There are 3 vocalists and a four-piece band ensemble for this production. The ensemble includes the following instrumentation -

- Lead guitar (and musical director)
- ✓ Bass guitar
- Keyboard
- ✓ Drums

For the 3 vocalists -

The production requires the use of three (3) wireless lavalier microphones for the three (3) vocalists. While the company travels with 3 (three) Shure PGX1 wireless lavalier microphones (or similar) for the vocalists, accompanying receivers and hook-ups, the company prefers to utilize these as back-up to the venue's house wireless lavalier microphones when the house has the capacity to provide them. This helps ensure compability for vocal amplification in each venue.

Four sound monitors are to be provided for the vocalists – location of the monitors is usually downstage (or lip of stage); and on each side of the stage; exact placement is an on-site decision.

For the 4-piece instrument ensemble –

- ✓ Four (4) standard black music stands.
- ✓ Four (4) monitors (one for each ensemble member) with 4-monitor & vocals mix capability.
- ✓ Lead Guitar (and band leader)
 - ✓ One (1) microphone for amp (not direct hook-up)
 - ✓ For un-routed tours Fender Deluxe III guitar amp and Fender Twin guitar amp provided by venue preferred, but regular amps okay.
 - ✓ guitar stand (dual guitar stand is okay)
 - ✓ Two (2) quarter-inch (¼ inch) guitar cables (10' length minimum)
 - ✓ seating padded w/ back support; standard height, no arms on seat.
- ✓ Bass Guitar -
 - ✓ One (1) microphone or cable hook-up to house system (direct)
 - ✓ For un-routed tours Aguilar bass head or David Eden bass amp head; 2x10 bass cabinet preferred; standard amp head & cabinet okay.
 - ✓ guitar stand (dual guitar stand is okay)
 - ✓ Two (2) quarter-inch (¼ inch) guitar cables (10' length minimum)
 - ✓ seating padded w/ back support; standard height, no arms on seat.
- Keyboard -
 - ✓ Two (2) microphones or cable hook-ups to house system— one for keyboard and one for special effects from keyboard.
 - ✓ seating padded w/ back support; standard height, no arms on seat.
- ✓ Drums -
 - ✓ Three (3) microphones two (2) overhead, and one (1) for kickdrum
 - ✓ Platform preferred not required.
 - ✓ seating standard drum throne.

- ✓ DRUMS Yamaha Absolute Maple preferred, not required.
 - ✓ toms: 10" 12" 16"
 - ✓ bass drum 22"
 - ✓ cymbal stands 3
 - ✓ cymbals 17 crash & 18 crash & 21 ride
 - ✓ Hi-Hat 14" & Hi-Hat & stands
 - ✓ snare drum 14x6 & snare stand
 - ✓ foot pedal
 - ✓ drum throne
- ✓ NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AMPLIFICATION AND HOOK-UPS (also listed with individual guitarist amp specs above for un-routed tours) -

 - ✓ Aguilar bass head or David Eden bass amp head; 2x10 bass cabinet preferred; standard amp head & cabinet okay.
